



ATC WORLDS BID DECLARATION FORM

2017 International Championship: Worlds Declaration & Worlds Bid requirements:

Paid Bid eligibility: ATC has set up regional and national requirements for those programs that are competing for our Worlds bids. In order to be eligible for our world's bids you must qualify under one of the following requirements:

Eligible for **ALL BIDS (2 paid, 4 at large)**.

Any program that does two of the following:

1. Attend any ATC Family regional event with a minimum 10 teams or 100% of your program.
2. Attend the International Championship with 50% or more of their program,
3. Must stay in an ATC International Championship host hotel during the competition weekend. **Does not apply to gyms inside a 30 mile radius of the venue.**

Eligible for **THREE BIDS (1 paid and 2 At Large)**.

Any program that does two of the following:

1. Attend any ATC Family regional event with a minimum 10 teams or 100% of your program.
2. Attend the International Championship, bringing a minimum of 2 additional teams. If you are a mega gym, the 2 additional teams must be from the same location as the Worlds team.
3. Attend an ATC Skillz Camps with a minimum of 3 teams.
 - a. ***If a gym does not have 3 teams, 100% gym participation is required for the camp.***
4. Must stay in an ATC International Championship host hotel during the competition weekend. **Does not apply to gyms inside a 30 mile radius of the venue.**

Worlds Bid Declaration:

Bids awarded: This year All Things Cheer (ATC) will be giving out 2 “Full Paid” and 4 “At Large” bids. ATC will be awarding the four most consistent, highest scoring teams throughout the entire competition.

Bid Divisions: ATC bids are open to all USASF bid eligible teams. See “paid bid eligibility”. Gyms must also be in good standing with the USASF and the Event Producer.

Scores: Scores will be “ 25% day one and 75% day two”

Bid Competition style:

There will be a total of two competitive rounds. The first round of competition will be the qualifying round. These are for all Level 5 and Level 6 teams. Once on Saturday and once on Sunday. At the end of the first two rounds, **one** full paid bid and **three** at large bids will be awarded to the top scoring BID ELIGIBLE teams. **One** full paid bid and **one** at large bid will be awarded at EP and Judges discretion.

ATC Tie Breaker: In the event of a tie, the teams with the same score will have to perform again. Each team will receive three minutes and thirty seconds on the warm up floor before taking the main floor to perform again. The team that executes their routine the best and scores the highest will win.
